

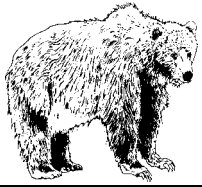

Shooting a Basic Sequence

Definition:

A **shot** is a continuous view from one camera.

A **sequence** is a series of shots complete in itself. It depicts an event or action.

Shooting Requirements:

Storyboard

Change camera angle 45⁰ or more between each shot

Change shot type with each shot

Consider composition of every shot

Depict an action

No camera motion

Eight shots

Vary camera height

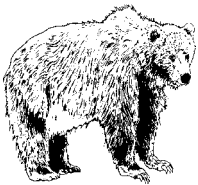
No Dialog

Editing Requirements:

Length: 15 to 60 seconds total length

Eight shots

Transitions: Straight cuts or dissolves (crossfades) only
